WATER –LEVEL 2 DROUGHT ALERT

The San Diego City council voted May 5th to move our city to a Level 2 Drought Alert. According to the San Diego Union Tribune, water-use restrictions will start June 1st. As a condominium community we need to be ready! Our Board of Directors is addressing this issue. What can you do? Please check your unit for any type of water leak (even very slow ones). Fix them immediately and/or call your landlord. Do you have a low flow toilet? For information on water wasted due to leaks, visit the Water Wiser Drip Calculator at www.awwa.org.
